AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF NORFOLK TO REIMBURSE THE COUNTY OF BRISTOL FOR THE EXPENSE OF A CERTAIN TRIAL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The County Commissioners of the County of Norfolk are
2 hereby authorized and directed to pay the County of Bristol the
3 Sum of Twenty-eight Thousand Eight Hundred Thirty-nine
4 Dollars and Thirty-eight Cents, as reimbursement for the expenses
5 incurred by said County of Bristol in connection with the trial, in
6 the year nineteen hundred and seventy-six, of James W. Blaikie,
7 Jr. for murder in the first degree, which trial was held in said
8 County of Bristol by reason of a change of venue from said County
9 of Norfolk.
