AN ACT REQUIRING THE USE OF SNOW TIRES ON MOTOR VEHICLES
BETWEEN CERTAIN DATES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 16 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by chapter 233 of the acts of 1974, is hereby further
3 amended by adding the following paragraph: —

4 No person shall operate a motor vehicle on a public way between
5 November first and April first unless said vehicle is equipped with
6 snow tires. Whoever violates the provisions of this paragraph shall
7 be punished by a fine of not more than fifty dollars.
