RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE FEASIBILITY OF ESTABLISHING A CRIMINAL IDENTIFICATION BUREAU IN NORFOLK COUNTY.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of two members  
2 of the senate, three members of the house of representatives, the  
3 chairman of the county commissioners of Norfolk county, the  
4 district attorney of Norfolk county, the sheriff of Norfolk county  
5 and two persons to be appointed by the governor, at least one to be  
6 a police chief, is hereby established for the purpose of making an  
7 investigation and study relative to the feasibility of establishing a  
8 criminal identification bureau in Norfolk county.
