AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF LAWRENCE TO APPROPRIATE A CERTAIN SUM OF MONEY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the
2 contrary, the City of Lawrence is hereby authorized to appropriate
3 the sum of One Thousand and Ten and 72/ 100 (\$1,010.72) Dollars
4 and to transfer said funds for the Bessie M. Burke Memorial
5 Hospital to reimburse said fund for a bill paid to the American
6 Arbitration Association in the amount of \$1,010.72 paid from said
7 fund in fiscal year 1977.

1 SECTION 2. Any action taken by the City of Lawrence, the
2 Board of Trustees of the Bessie M. Burke Memorial Hospital, the
3 Committee on Account on the part of the City Council, the City
4 Auditor and City Treasurer in approving and paying said bill is
5 hereby validated and confirmed as though this act was in effect at
6 the time such action was taken.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
