**AN ACT SUPPLEMENTING THE COST FOR RENTAL OF COURT FACILITIES
IN THE GENERAL APPROPRIATION ACT FOR FISCAL YEAR 1984**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. To provide for supplementing the cost for rental of Court facilities in the General Appropriation Act the sum
2 set forth in section two and subject to the conditions specified
3 therein is hereby appropriated from the General Fund, subject to the provisions of the law regulating the disbursement
4 of public funds and conditions pertaining to appropriations in
5 Chapter 191 of the Acts of the current year, for the fiscal year
6 ending nineteen hundred and eighty-three the sum so appropriated to be in addition to any amount at present available
7 for that purpose.
