AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A COLLECTION SYSTEM FOR BILLED DEPARTMENTAL RECEIVABLES IN CITIES/TOWNS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Amend Chapter 41, Section 38A by striking the second sentence
2 and inserting in place thereof the following: — “Such a collector
3 shall in the collection of such accounts have all the remedies
4 provided by section 58 of chapter 41, interest provisions of section
5 57 of chapter 59, section 15, Demand provisions of section 16,
6 as well as section 35, 36 and 93, all of chapter 60 for the collection
7 of taxes on personal estate”.
