The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

An Act providing for reimbursement to cities and towns for POLICE AND FIRE SERVICES FURNISHED TO CERTAIN STATE FACILITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Chapter 29 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- after section 27C the following section: -
- 3 Section 27D. The amounts expended by any city or town in providing police or fire department services to any correctional 4
- 5 or educational facility of the commonwealth located in said city
- or town, the name of the facility served, the reason for such
- services and such other details as the commissioner of public safety
- may require shall within the first ten days of the month following
- the month in which such expenditures were made, be certified to
- said commissioner on blank forms provided by him, in a manner 10
- approved by him by the head of the police or fire department, 11
- as the case may be, of said city or town. The commissioner shall 12
- examine such certificates, shall allow and endorse thereon such
- amounts as he finds to have been expended in accordance with 14
- this section and shall transmit the certificates to the comptroller. 15
- Such amounts shall be paid by the commonwealth to the several
- 17 cities and towns on or before November tenth of the fiscal year
- after such expenditures.
