AN ACT RELATIVE TO SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 7 of chapter 15 A of the General Laws, as appearing
- 2 in the 1986 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out,
- 3 in line 9, the words "ten nor more than twenty-five" and inserting
- 4 in place thereof the following word: — fifty.
