### AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING HEARINGS ON VIOLATIONS OF PARKING REGULATIONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The registrar of motor vehicles shall establish rules and  
2 regulations which shall provide that a person receiving a notice  
3 of a parking violation under the provisions of section twenty A  
4 or twenty A $\frac{1}{2}$  of chapter ninety of the General Laws shall be  
5 entitled to have the hearing, which is provided for under the  
6 provisions of said sections, held before a hearing officer at the  
7 branch office of the registry of motor vehicles which is closest to  
8 his place of residence if he so elects.

THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES PASSED A RESOLUTION  
MAY 1, 1898, AND THE SENATE PASSED A RESOLUTION  
MAY 1, 1898, RELATIVE TO THE LANDS BELONGING TO THE  
UNITED STATES.

THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE  
HAVE THE HONOR TO ACKNOWLEDGE THE RECEIPT OF THE  
RESOLUTIONS PASSED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF  
REPRESENTATIVES, AND TO STATE THAT THEY HAVE  
BEEN CAREFULLY CONSIDERED.

THE REPORT OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE GENERAL  
LAND OFFICE IS HEREBY SUBMITTED TO THE SENATE  
AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, IN RESPONSE  
TO THE RESOLUTIONS PASSED BY THEM, AND TO  
STATE THAT THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE GENERAL  
LAND OFFICE HAVE BEEN CAREFULLY CONSIDERING  
THE SAME, AND THAT THEY WILL BE REPORTING  
TO THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES  
AT AN EARLY DATE.
