The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Two.

AN ACT TO INCLUDE CERTAIN MONIES PAID TO ELSIE FETTERMAN FOR THE PURPOSES OF A RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section one of chapter thirty-
2 two of the General Laws or of any other general or special law
3 to the contrary, the state retirement board is hereby authorized
4 and directed to include bonus overscale payments so-called paid
5 to Elsie Fetterman, an employee of the University of Massachu-
6 setts, in the calendar years 1989, 1990, and 1991, as regular
7 compensation for the purposes of calculating her pension upon
8 the effective date of her retirement; provided, however, that said
9 Elsie Fetterman shall pay into the annuity fund of the state
10 retirement system an amount equal to the additional amount that
11 would have been deducted from her salary had such bonus
12 payments been considered regular compensation; and provided
13 further that said Elsie Fetterman shall also pay into the annuity
14 fund of the state retirement system an amount of interest such
15 that her total payment to the state retirement system under this
16 act shall equal the value of her additional accumulated deductions
17 for said years that would have resulted if such deductions had
18 actually been made when such bonus payments were actually
19 received.
