AN ACT

Standardizing the Salaries of the Treasurer and Receiver General and his Deputies.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The annual salary of the treasurer and
2 receiver general shall be seven thousand dollars.

1 SECTION 2. The annual salary of the present first
2 deputy in the office of the treasurer and receiver general
3 shall be five thousand dollars, and the annual salary of
4 the present second deputy shall be three thousand dollars.

1 SECTION 3. The increases in salary provided for by
2 this act shall take effect as of the first day of June, nine-
3 teen hundred and twenty.
