An Act relative to the Sale of "Grade A" Milk.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter ninety-four of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by inserting after section fourteen A thereof
- 3 the following new section:—
- 4 *Section 14B.* No person himself or by his servant
- 5 or agent shall sell, exchange or deliver or have in his
- 6 custody with intent so to do, or expose or offer for
- 7 sale or exchange, any milk marked or designated as
- 8 "Grade A" which is more than twenty-four hours
- 9 old when pasteurized at the distributor's city plant,
- 10 or which shall be more than forty-eight hours old when
- 11 delivered to the consumer.
