AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE RETURN OF A CERTAIN BID DEPOSIT TO THOMAS MULLANE & SONS, INC.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. In order to correct an inequity, there shall be
2 returned from the treasury of the commonwealth the sum of
3 two thousand dollars to Thomas Mullane & Sons, Inc., paid
4 by it as a bid deposit for roofing work to be done at Boston
5 State College, in as much as all other bid deposits for the same
6 work had been returned to all other bidders because there were
7 not sufficient funds available to let a contract based on such
8 bids.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
