AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEANS OF ADMISSION OF THE STATE COLLEGES AND THE UNIVERSITY OF MASSACHUSETTS TO ADMINISTER A SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM FOR STUDENTS ATTENDING INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The deans of admission of the state colleges and
2 of the University of Massachusetts shall administer a scholar-
3 ship program for the purpose of furnishing aid and assistance
4 to students domiciled in the commonwealth and enrolled in
5 and pursuing a program of higher education in any approved
6 public or private college, normal school, scientific or technical
7 institution, or any other approved institution furnishing a
8 program of higher education. Such aid and assistance shall
9 consist of the awarding of one quarter, one half, or full
10 scholarships to worthy and qualified students in need of
11 financial assistance, provided that not less than ten nor more
12 than twenty-five per cent of the total amount of scholarships
13 awarded in any one year shall be allotted to students at
14 institutions of higher education supported by the common-
15 wealth. The said deans shall establish such regulations
16 governing the eligibility and awarding of scholarships as it
17 shall deem necessary.

1 SECTION 2. Section 1D of chapter 15 of the General Laws,
2 as appearing in section 2 of chapter 572 of the acts of 1965,
3 is hereby amended by striking out the twentieth paragraph.
