AN ACT RELATIVE TO DISTRIBUTION OF THE RECREATIONAL BOATING
FUND.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 Chapter 90B of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 striking out section 16, inserted by section 2 of chapter 275
3 of the acts of 1960, and inserting in place thereof the following
4 section:—

5 *Section 16.* Moneys received by the commonwealth from fees,
6 taxes (motor fuel) and other sources pertaining to the adminis-
7 tration of this chapter shall be credited on the books of the
8 commonwealth to a fund to be known as the Recreational
9 Boating Fund. Said Recreational Boating Fund, subject to
10 appropriation, shall be used as follows:—

11 (1) For the payment of the administration and enforcement
12 expenses of the division.

13 (2) For conducting programs of boating safety education.

14 (3) For the dredging of channels and mooring areas used
15 for recreational boating.

16 (4) For the reimbursement to cities and towns, so far as pos-
17 sible, for such projects as are indicated in (2) above, provided,
18 the plans for such programs have been approved in advance by
19 the director.
