By Mr. Volterra of Attleboro, petition of Max Volterra (with the approval of the mayor and municipal council) that the city of Attleboro be authorized to pay a certain sum of money to the Willis MacKinnon Insurance Company. Local Affairs. [Local Approval Received.]

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF ATTLEBORO TO PAY A CERTAIN SUM OF MONEY TO THE WILLIS MACKINNON INSURANCE COMPANY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Attleboro is hereby authorized to
2 appropriate money for the payment of, and after such ap-
3 propriation, the treasurer of said city is hereby authorized to pay
4 to the Willis MacKinnon Insurance Company the sum of fourteen
5 thousand five hundred and nine dollars, for premiums for
6 workmen's compensation insurance coverage provided for said
7 city in the year nineteen hundred and seventy, payment for
8 which is legally unenforceable against said city.

1 SECTION 2. No bill shall be approved by the auditor of said
2 city for payment or paid by the treasurer thereof under authority
3 of this act unless and until a certificate has been signed and filed
4 with said city auditor, stating under the penalties of perjury that
5 the insurance coverage for which said bill has been submitted was
6 ordered by an official or an employee of said city, and that
7 coverage was actually provided for said city.

1 SECTION 3. Any person who knowingly files a certificate
2 required by section two, which is false and who thereby receives
3 payment for insurance coverage which was not received by said

4 city, shall be punished by imprisonment for not more than one
5 year or by a fine of not more than three hundred dollars, or
6 both.
