By Mr. Buffone of Worcester, petition of Charles J. Buffone and another that veterans of the Vietnam conflict be authorized to attend summer sessions and evening classes conducted by community colleges without charge for tuition. Education.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING VIETNAM VETERANS TO ATTEND SUMMER SESSIONS AND EVENING CLASSES CONDUCTED BY COMMUNITY COLLEGES WITHOUT CHARGE FOR TUITION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 39 of chapter 15 of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by adding the following sentence: — Vietnam veterans
- 3 may attend such summer sessions and evening classes tuition free.
- 4 Community colleges shall be reimbursed by the commonwealth
- 5 for the cost of instruction to each Vietnam veteran who attends
- 6 such summer sessions and such evening classes.
