## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Four.

AN ACT CREATING PREFERENCE FOR CIVIL SERVICE APPLICANTS WHO ARE DOMICILED IN THE CITY OR TOWN WHERE POSITION IS TO BE GRANTED.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 31 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 19C the following section: —
- 3 *Section 19D.* An applicant successfully completing a civil
- 4 service examination shall be granted an additional ten points to
- 5 his score, if said applicant is a domiciliary of the city or town of
- 6 the awarding authority.
