AN ACT INCLUDING CERTAIN FORMERLY EXCLUDED CLINICAL LABORATORIES UNDER THE LAW REQUIRING THE LICENSING OF CLINICAL LABORATORIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 111E of the General Laws, as appearing in section 2 1 of chapter 881 of the acts of 1975, is hereby amended by 3 striking out section 4.
