AN ACT RELATIVE TO REPEAL OF THE BARTLEY-FOX GUN LAW.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 *Whereas*, enacted Bill #6180 is not being implemented fully,  
2 by the Judiciary, due to stark unfairness in its general applica-  
3 tion.
- 4 *Whereas*, said Bill's enactment was effectuated, in the clos-  
5 ing days of legislative session, by parliamentary maneuver,  
6 allegedly snide, on the part of an outgoing Speaker of the  
7 House.
- 8 *Whereas*, said law poses direct conflict with the constitu-  
9 tional right to bear arms.
- 10 *Be it resolved that* said enacted Bill, #6180, be repealed.
