AN ACT PROVIDING THAT SCHOOL BUSES UNDER CONTRACT TO A SCHOOL SYSTEM MAY TRANSPORT PUPILS TO AND FROM CERTAIN ACTIVITIES WITHOUT PAYMENT FROM SCHOOL APPROPRIATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 11 A of Chapter 159 A of the General Laws is here-
2 by amended by striking out the last paragraph as appearing in
3 Chapter 68 of the Acts of 1980, and inserting in place thereof
4 the following new paragraph: —

5 This section shall not be construed so as to prohibit the use
6 of school buses under contract to a school system in trans-
7 porting pupils to and from summer school and school sponsored
8 extra curricular activities.
