AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PROPERTY TAX DEFERRAL FOR CERTAIN  
PERSONS OVER SIXTY-FIVE YEARS OF AGE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 5 of Chapter 59 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out the third paragraph in clause Forty-  
3 first A, as most recently amended by Chapter 258 of the Acts  
4 of 1978, and inserting in place thereof the following: —

5 (2) is a surviving spouse who inherits such real property  
6 and has occupied such real property or other real property  
7 in the commonwealth as his or her domicile for five years and  
8 who otherwise qualified under this clause; and provided fur-  
9 ther that such person, and such person and his spouse, if mar-  
10 ried, had, during the preceding year, gross receipts from all  
11 sources not in excess of fifty thousand dollars.
