AN ACT RELATIVE TO STATE REIMBURSEMENTS FOR STATE-OWNED PROPERTY WITHIN THE TOWN OF BRIDGEWATER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any special or general law to
- 2 the contrary, the town of Bridgewater shall be reimbursed for all
- 3 lost property tax revenue due to the state owned property located
- 4 within the town of Bridgewater. The reimbursement shall be based
- 5 on the property valuation as assessed by the town assessors.
