AN ACT RELATIVE TO INCOME AND ASSET INFORMATION PROVIDED TO HOUSING AUTHORITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 32 of Chapter 121B, as most recently amended by
- 2 Chapter 510 of the Acts of 1981, is hereby further amended by the
- 3 addition of the following paragraph: —
- 4 In determining the net income and assets of an applicant or
- 5 tenant for the purpose of computing rent, or determining eligibility
- 6 for admission, or determining eligibility for continued occupancy,
- 7 information provided by such applicant or tenant shall be given
- 8 under penalty of perjury. Furthermore, such information, as
- 9 provided by such applicant or tenant, shall be subject to verifica-
- 10 tion by the housing authority and to substantiation by the Bureau
- 11 of Special Investigations of the Commonwealth as established
- 12 pursuant to Chapter 7, Section 30T.
