AN ACT RELATIVE TO A MONUMENT TO VETERANS' GRAVES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 9 of Chapter 115 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by Chapter 214 of the Acts of 1976, is hereby amended by
3 inserting in the sixth sentence after the word "United States," the
4 following: — "or a flag on a suitable monument which shall be
5 dedicated to all veterans interred on every Memorial Day."
