### RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY OF CERTAIN ACTIVITIES OF DPU.

1     *Resolved*, There shall be a commission to study and evaluate  
2 the adequacy of rates, established by department of public  
3 utilities, paid small power generators and cogenerators. Said  
4 commission shall have nine members; three of whom shall be  
5 members of the house of representatives appointed by the speaker  
6 of the house; three shall be members of the senate appointed by  
7 the senate president; and three shall be appointed by the governor,  
8 one being a representative of a utility which purchases power from  
9 small power producers and cogenerators, and one being a small  
10 power producer. The commission shall make its report no later  
11 than twelve months after all appointments have been made.
