AN ACT RELATIVE TO ABORTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any contrary provision of law, no town, city,
- 2 county or state shall expend public funds for abortions and no
- 3 doctor or nurse shall be required by any clinic or hospital to
- 4 perform or participate in any abortion against their will.
