AN ACT FOR A SPECIAL LAW AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO USE CERTAIN PARK LAND IN THE CITY OF BOSTON FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A FIELD HOUSE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The City of Boston is hereby authorized to
2 construct a field house to be used for such purposes as, but not
3 limited to, equipment storage and restrooms, on a certain parcel
4 of land known as McConnell Park in Savin Hill in the Dorchester
5 section of the City of Boston.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
