AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE STATE RETIREMENT BOARD TO INCREASE THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE OF RUTH E. LACK.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law to the  
2 contrary and in order to promote the public good, the state  
3 retirement board is hereby authorized and directed to pay Ruth  
4 E. Lack, the widow of Judge Harry M. Lack, a survivor's  
5 allowance equal to the amount of pension Judge Harry M. Lack  
6 was receiving pursuant to section sixty-five (c) of chapter thirty-  
7 two of the Massachusetts General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
