**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

**AN ACT EXTENDING THE HISTORIC BEACON HILL DISTRICT IN THE CITY OF BOSTON.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 616 of the acts of 1955 is hereby  
2 amended by inserting after section 1C, inserted by section 1  
3 of chapter 622 of the acts of 1963, the following sections:—

4 *Section 1D.* The historic Beacon Hill district, created by  
5 section one and enlarged and extended by sections one A, one  
6 B and one C, is hereby further enlarged and extended to in-  
7 clude an area contiguous thereto bounded as follows:—  
8 northerly by Derne street; westerly by the westerly side line  
9 of Hancock street and said side line extended southerly to  
10 Beacon street; southerly by the northerly side line of Beacon  
11 street; southwesterly by Park street; southeasterly by Tre-  
12 mont street; northeasterly by the northerly boundaries of the  
13 granary burial ground and of the Boston Atheneum; north-  
14 westerly by Beacon street; and easterly by Bowdoin street.

15 *Section 1E.* The state house and its appurtenances within  
16 the historic Beacon Hill district as created by section one and  
17 enlarged and extended by sections one A, one B, one C and one  
18 D shall be exempt from the provisions of this act.

1 SECTION 2. Chapter 616 of the acts of 1966 is hereby  
2 further amended by striking out the words "land of the com-  
3 monwealth and " as appearing in section 1 thereof.

1 SECTION 3. Nothing in this act shall be construed to pre-  
 2 vent or affect the construction, reconstruction, alteration or  
 3 demolition of any structure within the areas defined by sec-  
 4 tion one of this act under a permit issued prior to the effective  
 5 date of this act by the building commissioner of the city of  
 6 Boston whether or not an exterior architectural feature is  
 7 involved.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
