AN ACT CREATING AN INSURANCE INTEREST IN CERTAIN VEHICLES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 175 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting  
2 after section 195 the following section: —

3 *Section 196.* Any person who has a certificate of title, author-  
4 ized by or in accordance with the registry of motor vehicles, to a  
5 motor vehicle shall be considered to have an insurable interest in  
6 said vehicle.

Resolved, That the Committee on the subject of the proposed amendments to the Constitution of the State of New York, do hereby report the following amendments to the Constitution of the State of New York, which amendments are hereby recommended to the Legislature for its consideration and action thereon.

ARTICLE I

Section 1. The Legislative Power of the State shall be vested in a Senate and an Assembly.

Section 2. The Senate shall be composed of twenty-four members, to be elected by the qualified electors of the State.

Section 3. The Assembly shall be composed of fifty members, to be elected by the qualified electors of the State.

Section 4. The members of the Senate shall hold office for two years, and shall be eligible for re-election.

Section 5. The members of the Assembly shall hold office for one year, and shall be eligible for re-election.
