AN ACT EXTENDING THE AUTHORITY OF THE PARK COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF BOSTON TO LEASE LAND OR BUILDINGS UNDER THEIR CONTROL FOR BOATHOUSES AND OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The board of park commissioners of the
2 city of Boston may lease any land or buildings under
3 their control to be used for boathouses, refectories and
4 other purposes, including anything that may be rea-
5 sonably deemed for the convenience or accommodation
6 of the public, including amusements, and may grant
7 concessions for keeping boats, carriages or other
8 things for the accommodation or convenience of the
9 public, including amusements, for such terms and on
10 such conditions as the board, with the approval of the
11 mayor, may deem proper; provided, that nothing in
12 this act shall be so construed as to affect in any way
13 any contract or agreement entered into by said board
14 prior to the passage of this act.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
