## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Five.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE PLYMOUTH COUNTY DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL, INC. SHALL BE A MEMBER OF THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON VACATION TRAVEL ESTABLISHED TO ASSIST THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE AND DEVELOPMENT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 6 of chapter 23A of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out the first paragraph, as most recently  
3 amended by section 6 of chapter 761 of the acts of 1968, and  
4 inserting in place thereof the following paragraph: —  
5 To assist the department in the discharge of its duties the  
6 commissioner shall appoint, without regard to chapter thirty-one  
7 but with the approval of the governor, advisory committees from  
8 among interested citizens of the commonwealth. There shall be  
9 advisory committees on manpower development training;  
10 regional planning; commercial and industrial development;  
11 vacation travel, which shall consist of seventeen members  
12 including the chief executive officers of the thirteen regional  
13 associations known as the Berkshire Hills Conference, Inc.,  
14 Central Massachusetts Tourist Council, Inc., Essex County  
15 Tourist Council of Massachusetts, Inc., Cape Cod Chamber of  
16 Commerce, Greater Boston Chamber of Commerce, Martha's  
17 Vineyard Chamber of Commerce, Mohawk Trail Association,  
18 Nantucket Island Chamber of Commerce, Inc., Pioneer Valley  
19 Association, Inc., Plymouth Chamber of Commerce, Inc.,  
20 Plymouth County Development Council, Inc., Old Sturbridge  
21 Inc. and The Tourist Council of Bristol County, Inc., science and  
22 technology; international trade; and a women's advisory com-  
23 mittee.
