

SENATE No. 148.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Seventy-Seven.

AN ACT

To authorize the County Commissioners of Bristol County to Lay Out Highways and Build Bridges across Lee's River and Cole's River in the Towns of Somerset and Swanzey.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECT. 1. The county commissioners of Bristol
2 County may, if in their opinion public convenience
3 and necessity require, lay out a highway and con-
4 struct a bridge over Lee's River, between the towns
5 of Somerset and Swanzey, in said county, and also
6 over Cole's River in said Swanzey, or either of
7 them, above the railroad bridges now existing over
8 said rivers; the plans and locations of said bridges,

9 and each of them, shall be subject to the approval
10 and direction of the board of harbor commissioners,
11 who shall also determine whether either or both
12 said bridges shall be built without a draw or draws,
13 providing said bridge or bridges can be built with-
14 out assessing any part of the cost thereof upon
15 the county or town.

1st SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
