In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Seventy-Four.

AN ACT

To repeal Chapter Seventy-five of the Acts of the Year One thousand eight hundred and seventy, in relation to laying out Highways.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter seventy-five of the acts of the year one
2 thousand eight hundred and seventy is hereby re-
3 pealed. And all provisions of law repealed by
4 said act are hereby revived: *provided*, that the
5 provisions of chapter two hundred and sixty-one
6 of the acts of the year one thousand eight hundred
7 and seventy-three, shall be held to apply to the
8 laws hereby revived. This act shall not affect any
9 cases pending at the time the same shall take
10 effect.
