AN ACT

To authorize the Trustees of the Methodist Church in
Winthrop to sell certain Real Estate.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. The trustees of the Methodist Episcopal
2 Church in Winthrop, are hereby authorized to sell
3 and make conveyance of the real estate in said town
4 held by them in trust, known as the chapel lot, being
6 the premises conveyed to trustees for said church by
7 deeds of Joseph Belcher, recorded with Suffolk
8 deeds, liber three hundred and eighty-four, folio one
9 hundred and sixty-eight; and of James M. Belcher,
10 recorded, liber eight hundred and twenty three, folio
11 eighty-eight.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
