AN ACT

In addition to the Acts to supply the City of Worcester with Pure Water.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :

1 SECTION 1. The city of Worcester is hereby au-
2 thorized to take and convey into and through said
3 city the waters of Tatnic brook, or of any reservoir
4 thereon, and the waters flowing into the same, and
5 to take and hold any land, and build and maintain
6 any structures, necessary for said purpose.

1 SECT. 2. The rights, powers, and authorities given
2 by this act shall be exercised by the city of Worces-
3 ter, by the same officers as the rights, powers, and
4 authorities given by the one hundred and fourth
5 chapter of the Acts of the year eighteen hundred
6 and sixty-four are exercised by, and the said city
7 shall be entitled to all the rights, and subject to all

8 the duties and liabilities, to be enforced in the man-
9 ner provided in the three hundred and sixty-first
10 chapter of the Acts of the year eighteen hundred
11 and seventy-one.

1 SECT. 3. For the purpose of defraying all costs
2 and expenses incident to the acts herein authorized,
3 including the payment for land and water-rights
4 taken, the city council shall have authority to bor-
5 row, from time to time, such sums of money, and to
6 issue notes, bonds or certificates therefor, to be de-
7 nominated on the face thereof "Worcester Water
8 Scrip," as they shall deem necessary, to an amount
9 not exceeding five hundred thousand dollars, upon
10 the same terms and conditions, and with the same
11 authority in regard to interest, and the sale of said
12 scrip, and the payment of the principal thereof, and
13 the appropriation and assessment of money for the
14 payment of the principal and the interest on the
15 moneys so borrowed, as are contained in the fifth sec-
16 tion of the one hundred and fourth chapter of the
17 Acts of the year eighteen hundred and sixty-four.

1 SECT. 4. This act shall take effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
