

HOUSE No. 751.

[Bill accompanying the petition of Citizens' Law and Order League.
Liquor Law.]

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-seven.

AN ACT

To provide that Places Licensed in the City of Boston for the sale of Intoxicating Liquors shall be Confined to a Specified District in said City.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. That licenses of the first five classes to
2 sell intoxicating liquor, with the exception of fifth class
3 licenses to brewers, shall hereafter be granted or issued
4 to be exercised upon premises in the city of Boston lo-
5 cated within a district in any other portion of the city of
6 Boston than that described in the second section of this
7 act.

1 SECT. 2. The district in the city of Boston within
2 which only licenses for the sale of intoxicating liquor

3 shall be granted shall be bounded as follows: Beginning
4 at the junction of Causeway and Leverett streets to ex-
5 tend thence through Causeway and Commercial streets,
6 Atlantic avenue and Federal street and Dorchester ave-
7 nue to the junction of that avenue and Dover street,
8 thence through Dover and Berkeley streets to Columbus
9 avenue thence through Columbus avenue and Boylston
10 street along Boylston street and Tremont street to Tre-
11 mont row, Court and Green streets to Leverett street to
12 the point of beginning.

1 SECT. 3. Licenses may be granted to be exercised
2 upon both sides of the streets bounding the above de-
3 scribed district. Any license granted to be exercised in
4 any other part of the city of Boston than within the dis-
5 trict described in section two of this act shall be void.

1 SECT. 4. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
