AN ACT

Making Appropriations for Salaries and Expenses in the Department of the Surgeon-General of the Militia.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are
2 appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of the
3 commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue, for the
4 purposes specified, for the fiscal year ending on the
5 thirtieth day of November, nineteen hundred and
6 nine.

7 For the salary of the surgeon-general, twelve
8 hundred dollars. (Acts 1908, ch. 604, sect. 36.)

(Appropriation 1908, \$1,200.)

9 For medical supplies for use of the volunteer
10 militia, and for incidental and contingent expenses
11 of the surgeon-general, including clerical services
12 and printing the annual report, a sum not exceed-
13 ing twenty-five hundred dollars. (Acts 1908, ch.
14 604.)

(Appropriation 1908, \$2,400.)

15 For expenses in connection with the examination
16 of recruits for the militia, a sum not exceeding
17 twenty-six hundred dollars. (Acts 1908, ch. 604.)
(Appropriation 1908, \$2,600.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
