HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, April 24, 1880.

The Committee on Liquor Law, to whom was referred an Order to ascertain the number of licenses granted in the several cities and towns, and to report what legislation is necessary in regard to limiting the number of licenses, have forwarded to each city and town shown by the report of the Auditor to have granted licenses since May 1, 1879, and append herewith the returns as far as they have been received. In some cases the number granted is equal to 1 for each 150 of the population.

In view of the lateness of the session, we recommend the reference of the subject to the Next General Court.
