In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty.

AN ACT

Concerning the Election of Moderator in the Town of
Richmond.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The election of moderator made at
2 the town meeting in the town of Richmond, on the
3 twelfth day of April in the current year, so far as
4 the same may appear illegal for the reason that the
5 check list was not used in said election is hereby
6 ratified and confirmed, and the same shall be taken
7 and deemed good and valid in law to all intents and
8 purposes whatsoever.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
