AN ACT

By which Hearings under the Provisions of the Workmen's Compensation Act may be reserved and reported for the Consideration of the Full Court of the Supreme Judicial Court upon the Law and the Evidence.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The industrial accident board may reserve
2 and report the evidence and all questions of law arising
3 in cases heard by it to the superior court with the re-
4 quest that the same receive the consideration of the full
5 court of the supreme judicial court; and if the justice
6 of the superior court is of opinion that the case is a
7 proper one to receive the consideration of the full court,
8 he will reserve and report the evidence and all questions
