AN ACT RELATIVE TO VIDEO AND AUDIO PATIENT PROTECTION SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Subsection (d) of Section 203 of Chapter 111 is hereby amended
- 2 by adding the following sentence:—
- 3 Every licensed hospital shall make audio and visual recordings of
- 4 all surgeries. Failure to make such recordings may be punishable by
- 5 a fine determined by the commissioner. Upon passage of this bill it
- 6 shall be named the Leona S. Trabucco law.
