### AN ACT

In relation to Notice to Creditors of Persons arrested on Mesne Process and Execution.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—*

1 Whenever the notice, permitted by the thirteenth  
2 section of the one hundred and twenty-fourth chapter  
3 of the General Statutes, shall be served by leaving a  
4 copy thereof at the last and usual place of abode of  
5 the plaintiff or creditor, his agent or attorney, not  
6 less than twenty-four hours shall be allowed before  
7 the time appointed for the examination.
