AN ACT

To amend an Act to Establish the Office of Auditor
in Towns.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 Section one of chapter two hundred and ninety-
2 five of the acts of eighteen hundred and eighty-
3 six is hereby amended so as to read as follows:
4 Every town shall, at its annual meeting, choose
5 one or more auditors, who shall be sworn and
6 shall not hold any other town office.
