BOSTON – Tomorrow, Governor Charlie Baker will join Secretary of Energy and Environmental Affairs Matthew Beaton, Department of Conservation and Recreation Commissioner Leo Roy, and local officials to participate in a tree planting ceremony to commemorate the 10,000th tree being planted as part of the Greening the Gateway Cities Program.
