By Ms. Noble of Boston, petition of Elaine Noble and other members of the House relative to reviving and continuing the special commission established (under Chapter 26 of the Resolves of 1975) to make an investigation and study relative to the effect of the ratification of the proposed amendments to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and the Constitution of the United States prohibiting discrimination on account of sex upon the laws, business communities and public in the Commonwealth. Rules of the two branches, acting concurrently.

RESOLVE REVIVING AND CONTINUING THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ESTABLISHED TO MAKE AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY RELATIVE TO THE EFFECT OF THE RATIFICATION OF THE PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE CONSTITUTION OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS AND THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES PROHIBITING DISCRIMINATION ON ACCOUNT OF SEX UPON THE LAWS, BUSINESS COMMUNITIES AND PUBLIC IN THE COMMONWEALTH.

1 *Resolved*, That the special commission established by chapter
2 twenty-six of the resolves of nineteen hundred and seventy-five,
3 and most recently revived and continued by chapter one of the
4 resolves of nineteen hundred and seventy-six is hereby further
5 revived and continued. Said commission shall report not later
6 than December thirty-first nineteen hundred and seventy-
7 seven.
