CHAP. XXXIII.

An Act for the relief of the Danvers Cotton Factory in Danvers.

BE *it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same,* That the laws heretofore passed relative to alewives in the waters running into Ipswich river, be and they hereby are repealed, so far as not to require the continuance of Fish ways at the Danvers Cotton Factory, in the town of Danvers, or in the stream running thither from Humphry's pond.
