AN ACT CONCERNING BANKS.

Chap. 214

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows :

The time, when section first of chapter two hundred and nine of the acts of the last session of the legislature shall take effect, is hereby extended to the first day of December next.

Time extended.

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FOUR OF THE GENERAL STATUTES, "OF ARREST, IMPRISONMENT AND DISCHARGE."

Chap. 215

Be it enacted, &c., as follows :

SECTION 1. Section five of chapter one hundred and twenty-four of the General Statutes is hereby amended by inserting at the end of the first paragraph before the word "First," the words "that he believes and has good reason to believe."

Section five amended.

SECTION 2. The fifteenth section of said chapter is hereby amended by striking out in said section the words "the magistrate who issued it or any other magistrate named in section one," and inserting in place thereof the words "some magistrate named in section nine."

Section fifteen amended.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
