

AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF THE FOXBOROUGH STATE HOSPITAL. *Chap. 77*

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are appropriated for the maintenance of the Foxborough state hospital for the fiscal year ending on the thirtieth day of November, nineteen hundred and ten, to wit: —

From the receipts of said hospital now in the treasury of the commonwealth, the sum of thirteen thousand three hundred forty-nine dollars and seventy cents; and from the treasury of the commonwealth from the ordinary revenue, a sum not exceeding eighty-two thousand fifty dollars and thirty cents.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR SALARIES AND EXPENSES IN THE DEPARTMENT OF THE SURGEON GENERAL OF THE MILITIA. *Chap. 78*

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of the commonwealth from the ordinary revenue, for the department of the surgeon general, for the fiscal year ending on the thirtieth day of November, nineteen hundred and ten, to wit: —

Appropriations.

For the salary of the surgeon general, twelve hundred dollars.

For medical supplies for use of the volunteer militia, and for incidental and contingent expenses of the surgeon general, including clerical services and the printing of the annual report, a sum not exceeding twenty-five hundred dollars.

For expenses in connection with the examination of recruits for the militia, a sum not exceeding three thousand dollars.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
